While a sixth person is not required, there is a spot for ONE (1) more fisherman/expert liar to join the fun on board the Alpha One Charter for what will surely be a very memorable trip! Captain Rusch will guide and instruct you in the ways of drift fishing along the shoreline, where the quarry will be Smallmouth Bass and Walleye. Both of these game fish species are renowned for their powerful, deep-diving runs and drag-blistering fighting spirit! All rods & reels, terminal tackle and bait will be provided by the Captain. And yes, there is a head on the boat.

The approximate cost <u>per person</u> for the charter and a one-day fishing license is \$150.00 (One-Hundred-Fifty-and-No-Dollars). That's less than \$19 an hour to do some world-class fishing for not one but two legendary fighters.

The remaining slot on board Alpha One Charter will be allotted on a <u>first come</u>, <u>first served basis</u>.

Captain Rusch does have a second boat available ("Alpha Two Charter") that can accommodate up to six people, it would be piloted by one of his certified captains.
